### **CPI Corrugated Sector Multipoint Gluers Guarding Standards**

This standard launched in May 2005 and supported by HSE, was designed to assist members in the Risk Assessment process and enable them to establish effective guarding controls that addressed operational standards. Following approval by the Corrugated Council, the standard was included in the sector action plan with an agreed target date for guarding updates of March 2006.

HSE Inspectors through PABIAC have been made aware of this guidance and members are advised that, during the course of an Inspector's visit, they may be asked on progress to date.

The Health & Safety Committee is now seeking some feedback on this guidance that will assist in evaluating its effectiveness and could help in the production of future industry specific guidance. We would be most grateful if you could take the time to complete and return the short questionnaire (attached) that is designed to help us assess this initiative.
